The Department of Social Welfare & Both Ends Believing visited ECCT to learn from our experience with the Children's First Software.

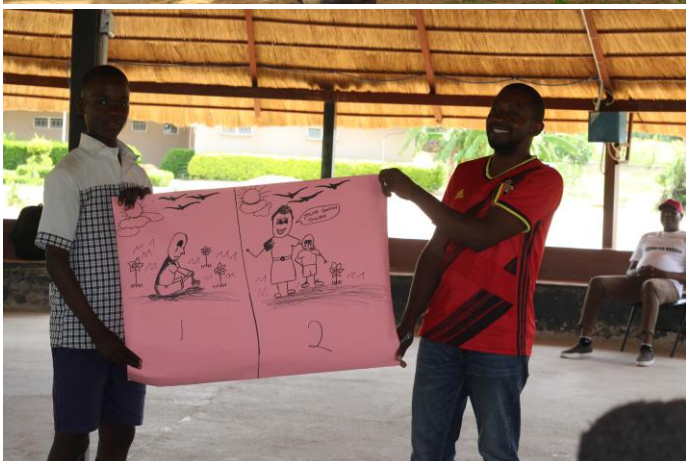

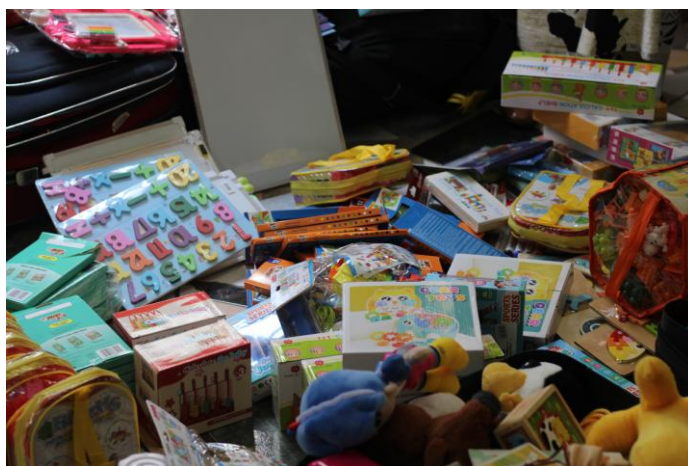

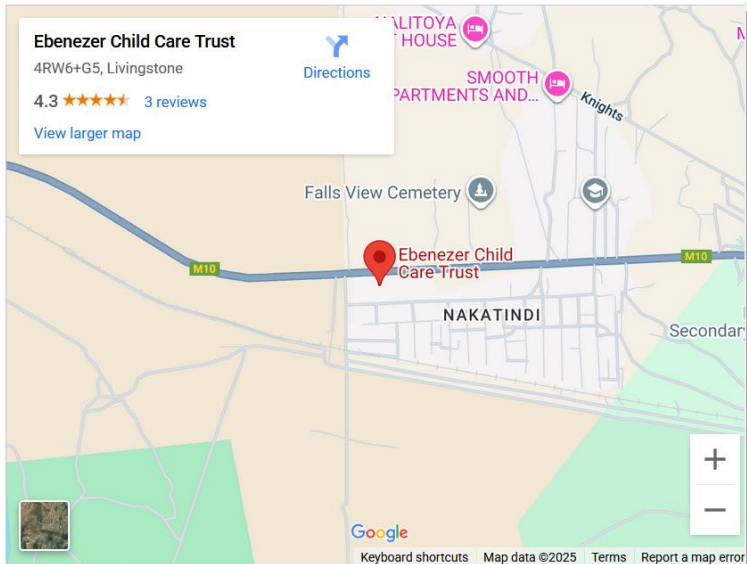
